Prof. Zafer Toprak

Professor Zafer Toprak graduated from the French High School, St-Joseph in Istanbul and the Diplomatic and Foreign Relations branch of the Faculty of Political Science in Ankara. He holds a master's degree from London University and doctorates from Istanbul University and St. Olaf College, Minnesota. His academic studies concentrated on 19th and 20th century Turkey. He published 20 books and more than 250 articles in Turkish, English, French, Italian, and Japanese.
